## U9's 2010 Football Carnival Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2010

### General Information:

- The carnival is by invitation only. The event has been sanctioned by Football Brisbane.
- Teams invited are required to field the team that are playing together in the 2010 season.
- The format of the carnival is 4 Pools of 4 teams. Team pools will be named A through to D and allocated a specific playing area.
- All games will be 10 minutes each way with a 2 minute half time.
- The top 2 teams from each pool will go forward to the Level 2 of the Carnival.
- The winners of the Level 2 will advance to Level 3 with the winners advancing to play a SSG Exhibition game.

More detailed Carnival rules can be found on page 3 hereinafter.

- Each player playing in the Exhibition Match will be rewarded with a trophy or a medal.
- All teams must be registered by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2010.
- The cost of entry is \$60 per team and must be paid by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2010.
- Team Registration and Briefing will commence at 8-15am with the first pool games scheduled to commence at 9am. We ask kindly that all teams are on time to ensure that the Carnival can run smoothly and on time.

All players, coaches and parents/guardians agree to the following:

- We will abide by all carnival rules as advised by the Slacks Creek Soccer Club. *(Note: a Carnival Controller will be appointed for the day. The decisions of the Carnival Controller are final).*
- We will participate in accordance with the True Sport Lives Here philosophy which means *we value integrity, respect, fun, true sportsmanship and responsibility.*

# RULES OF PARTICIPATION

## **We need your help to ensure the safety of your children**

In hosting the Carnival, Slacks Creek Soccer Club has done everything practicable to ensure the safety of your children.

**However, we require parents, coaches and managers to take responsibility for the safety of your own children and the children in your team.**

1. The carnival is by invitation only and for teams who are playing together in the 2010 season.
2. Players and teams must play in the age group they are playing in during the 2010 season.
3. All teams must be registered by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2010 and completed and returned the team registration form on page 2.
4. Unless specified otherwise in these rules, all games are to be played in accordance with the rules set out by Football Brisbane. Copies of these rules are available at the Football Brisbane website and will be available for viewing at the club house during the carnival.
5. Any grievance, protest or complaint should be made to the Slacks Creek officials at the main carnival control desk. The final decision is to be given by the Carnival Controller who has been appointed by Slacks Creek Soccer Club.
6. Whilst there are various levels in the carnival, we ask that all players, parents/guardians and coaches partake in the spirit of small sided football with the emphasis on fun and participation.
7. Any players playing in an older age group must comply with the Football Queensland player policy including completion of the *Application for Permission to Participate at Different Age Level* prior to the commencement of the Carnival.
8. All games will be played 10 minutes each way with a 2 minute half time. To assist with a quick turn around it is recommended that the players remain on the side of the field for half time and each team bring a second goal keeper jersey.
9. The start, half time, second half and end of games will be directed by the siren. No stoppage time for whatever reason will be added. We require that the coaches/managers have their teams ready to start on the siren.
10. All team Managers and coaches will be provided a copy of the schedule of games.
11. Team numbers are 7 on field players with a maximum squad size of 11 players.
12. The format of the carnival is 4 Pools of 4 teams. Team pools will be named A through to D.
13. Each team will play a minimum of 3 games. The top 2 teams from each pool will go forward to the Level 2 games. The group placing will be determined on a points basis. 3 points are awarded for a win, 1 point for a draw and no points for a loss. The final placing within the group will be determined on points. If 2 teams are on equal points, the placing will be determined on the ratio of goals for and against. If 2 teams are still equal the placing will be based on the number of goals scored and if still no placing can be determined then the team with the fewer number of goals conceded will determine the final placing. If after the sequence above that 2 teams are still equal the placement of the group will be based on their pool result against each other. If we are still unable to determine final placement of the teams, a sudden death penalty shoot out will occur.
14. The winners of the Level 2 games will advance to Level 3 with the winners advancing to play in the SSG Exhibition game. If at the end of the Level 2 and Level 3 games the scores are equal, a sudden death extra time will be played to a maximum of 5 minutes with the first team to score to advance to the next level. If after 5 minutes of extra time, the 2 teams are equal, a sudden death penalty shoot out will occur until such time one team scores and another misses.
15. Instructing referees will be provided for each game.
16. The team players partaking in the Carnival Exhibition game will be rewarded with a trophy or a medal.

*Please note, Slacks Creek Soccer Club have attempted to cover all aspects of the carnival for ease and fair play of competition and we ask you kindly to respect the final decision of the Carnival Controller and remember that we are here to have fun.*
