**Subject:** 10-27 – Allocation of Positions on Competition Ladders For Junior Competitions

In the event that a particular divisional competition cannot play an exact number of rounds in a normal season (14 games), the final team positions prior to the finals series will be determined by the following method:

- All teams will play the number of fixtures required to complete a normal season regardless of the number of teams in a division.
- These games will be drawn randomly.
- At the completion of the season proper, teams will have their best result against each opposing team used to determine the position on the ladder. (i.e. if a team plays another team more than once, only the best result from the two games is counted).

### Premierships and the teams for the Finals series will be determine this way.

- The Premiership table will be removed from the website after the first round.
- This process will apply to divisions that have:
 

• 9 teams in the competition	• 11 teams in the competition
• 10 teams in the competition	• 12 teams in the competition
- In the event of teams finishing on equal points, the normal process to distinguish final positions between teams as defined in the rules of competition will occur.

For a **13 team competition**, one full round will be played with a one week break during the season.

For a **5 or 6 team competition**, teams will play three (3) full rounds and therefore will require an additional match to be scheduled during the season. Football Brisbane will be in contact with clubs that have teams involved in a 6 team competition shortly.
